## Re: Parental Update on the End and Start of Term

Firstly, we hope you are well. It has been a busy and exciting term at The City of Leicester College and we want to share with you the details of the last day of term and first day back for you to make necessary arrangements.

## **End of the Summer Term**

The last day of term is **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July**. This day will finish at **12:25** for all year groups. This day will be a non-uniform day with £1 donations going to our school's chosen charity. Students will still be expected to wear their lanyards and have all equipment for their lessons. We are still waiting on confirmation if the 1005 bus will be running at 12:30 on the last day of term but we will let you know as soon as we do.

## **Start of the Autumn Term**

The first day of term is **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> August**. The start times will be slightly staggered to allow Year 7 a longer induction to that of the other year groups. We aim to then get students into their subject lessons as quickly as possible.

Year Group	Time	Entrance
Year 7	08:30	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their new tutors. The entrance will be open at 08:15.
Year 8	09:15	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:00
Year 9	09:15	Arrive at the community entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:00
Year 10	09:15	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:00
Year 11	09:15	Arrive at the side entrance (at the top of the outside steps). The entrance will be open at 09:00

## **Term Dates**

Please note, in addition to the Leicester City Council published dates we have additional staff inset days on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2023.
