Re: Parental Questionnaire

We would like to invite you to share your views and opinions about The City of Leicester College through completing our parental questionnaire. The TCOLC questionnaire is a series of 24 questions covering a range of topics including, quality of education, academic achievement, pastoral care, and safeguarding.

Your child has already had the opportunity to use their voice to make a difference here at TCOLC. Back in January 2022, 622 students completed the student questionnaire about the school. It was pleasing to hear that so many of our wonderful students enjoy coming to school, feel safe, encouraged to be independent and to take on responsibilities. Such a large majority of student respondents acknowledge TCOLC encourages them to respect people from other backgrounds and to treat everyone equally. We used the student feedback to make immediate changes, such as introducing The Hive, our student information hub, to make it easier for students to find safeguarding and personal development information quickly and with ease. We are also reinstating some of the pre-covid routines and rules around corridor behaviour and entrance and exits from classrooms as this was something that students wanted to see tightened up and back in place.

Your opinions about TCOLC and your child's education and happiness at the school really do matter to us! By helping us identify the things we do well and the areas we need to focus our improvements means we can provide our community with a truly ambitious education that allows all students to flourish.
