Dear Parent/Carer,

While Leicester did not see the worst of it, I was still appalled by the scenes we all saw on the news and across social media and wanted to assure you that The City of Leicester College remains a welcoming place for all. - Year 13: 09:30 at the main entrance.

Year 12 will begin the following week to allow for setting up of timetables following enrolment this week. Please ensure that your children are in full uniform, with no prohibited items such as long fake nails, so that we can begin the year positively and not with conflict or having students miss learning.
