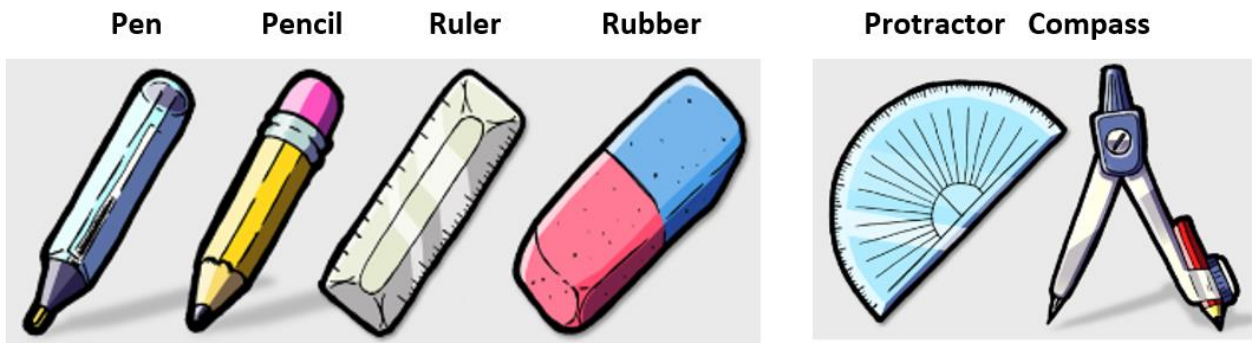
You can select any year and find papers and markschemes for both tiers of entry so choose the foundation or higher
